## **Alt DCM Report**

#### 1. GSR School

There was no GSR School held on April 21<sup>st</sup> because there was no need in April. The next GSR School will be held virtually on May 16th at 3:00 p.m.

The GSR School brings new GSRs and Alternate GSRs up to speed on their responsibilities in this role to their home group and to District 34. It also serves as a refresher course. These roles fulfill a very important job in AA because their purpose is to bring each group's voice to the District, to the Area and to the General Service Office of AA.

Craig worked with Districts 31 and 35 to plan Unity Day for 2021. The virtual Unity Day will take place on Saturday June 12<sup>th</sup>, starting at 10:00 a.m. The entire celebration will last 2-1/2 hours and will include a 1 hour speaker (TBA - Dave C.?), with the remaining time set aside for workshops to be held in breakout rooms. The workshops will be focused on general service. The purpose of Unity Day is to celebrate the founding of AA and give the attendees a chance to fellowship with others in Area 51. Flyers and more information will be forthcoming.

## **DCM Report**

- 1. The Spring Assembly will be held virtually on May 22<sup>nd</sup>. Details about the assembly were emailed to everyone. This is hopefully the last virtual assembly. The Assembly begins at 9:00 on Saturday with the "How the Assembly Operates" session. Workshops will be held from 10:15 11:15 and the assembly business takes place between Noon and 5 p.m. Debra A., AAWS directory, is the Saturday evening speaker at 6:00.
  - a. There will be discussion and a vote taken on the proposal to Retain the Site Investigation Subcommittee as presently composed and configured, but change the subcommittee schedule to allow site recommendations for Winter and Summer Committee meetings to be made no later than 2 years prior to the year of the event. The intent is to be able to reserve a venue closer to the event when the event will be one of the smaller ones. They want to maintain the 2 year requirement for the large events, but want more flexibility with the smaller events.

- Sue and Craig will vote according to the District conscience. It is expected that there will be discussion on the wording of this proposal.
- b. There was no feedback from the D34 groups regarding this Site Committee proposal. GSRs can send their group's comments and/or vote via email before the Assembly.
- 2. 74<sup>th</sup> NC State convention is July 15-18<sup>th</sup>. This will be virtual because of the large number of people who would attend and concerns about Covid restrictions and the hotel's concerns.
- **3.** The Fall Assembly is in-person is at Lake Junaluska Nov 13-14<sup>th</sup>. The venue is a little bit of a distance, but is quite beautiful. Perfect for the Fall! Sue recommends reserving a room at the Terrace Hotel to avoid having to walk up a hill to the other lodging. #### **Old Business**

- Discussion on the Proposed New Surplus Policy (from last month's meeting):
  - o If there is a surplus, up to \$500 will be spent on a district picnic.
  - o If surplus > \$500. Add an Alcothon for some other holiday, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Thanksgiving or Cinco de Mayo were discussed. They are open to other suggestions. Up to a \$1000 budget. This would be under a trial run for 1 year to see how successful it is. NOTE: if this event is not held or the funds are bookmarked for the following year's event (pre-funding), then this step is skipped and the monies roll to the next item. NOTE: This can be skipped, if on setting aside funds, the GSRs decide by a simple majority that they wish to skip it this year.
  - Remaining monies. Add a scholarship fund for GSR/Alt room and board to attend an Area 51 Assembly. This would be intended for small groups that cannot afford to send their GSR to the Area 51 Assembly Meeting. This will be capped

at the maximum amount left after reserving money for the mid-year alcothon. At this time it would be capped at \$1061.68.

- o Distribute remaining funds to GSO.
- For an example of expenses current set aside for the DCM and Alt DCM to attend an assembly: Hotel \$230 (2 nights), Meals \$75 (2 days), Travel \$30. Total is \$335. At this rate, we could send a GSR from 5 groups and the total cost would be \$1675.
- 5 GSRs voiced that their groups did not support an alcothon in the middle of the year and would like to see the surplus go to the scholarship fund instead. Two groups had an almost split decision on the alcothon vs. scholarship. One group thought it would be difficult to put together a middle of the year alcothon this year. One group indicated that their group would need a scholarship because they are so small.
- It is most likely that we could put together a picnic for mid-year but the alcothon would probably have to be next year.
- Took a vote of those who would like to NOT have an extra alcothon. 8 voted No to consider spending surplus money on an additional alcothon. 3 abstaning. We will strike the mid-year alcothon from the Surplus Policy.
- Motion to accept the modified proposal without the mid-year alcothon: Mark S. Second: Sue . Passed with no opposition.

#### **New Business**

1. It was discussed and a vote taken - Hybrid District 34 meetings will start with the June 2021 meeting. Sue and Craig will be at the Masonic Lodge in person. Zoom will continue for those who want to attend virtually. The Service Manual Study will be started up again in July.

#### **History Fact**

April History Fact presented by: Sue H. The book <u>Not God and anonymity</u>. Indicated that AA was a fellowship and not an organization. Who the heck is Rollie Hemsley? He was a hard-drinking professional catcher in baseball who raised questions of the preservation of anonymity early on in AAs history. He revealed his association with AA publicly in a press conference. This was in 1940. It is so easy to break someone else's anonymity by accident. Social media and on-line activity make this a dynamic topic.
