 - The background to conference agenda items is over 1000 pages!
 - The Delegate needed to review everything and then pulled out the "highlighted" items that we would take back to our groups this was done back in January. The reason the background is so big is because these agenda items, topics, areas or discussion and concern, suggestions, etc., come from A.A. members from all over. Anyone can write to the GSO. The Board tries to include as much information as possible to the conference agenda based on feedback and inputs provided from A.A. membership. There is an editing process, but the Board does a great job capturing all feedback.
 - Doug C. If the Delegate only picked (highlighted) 5-6 items, what happens to be remaining agenda items?
 - Craig at the Pre-Conference it is assumed you have already reviewed the agenda and have seen some of the items that would be of the utmost interest to your respective groups and members. Rainer (NC Delegate) pulled out the "hot topics" he felt were absolutely necessary to bring elevated levels of attention to.
 - Regarding the topic of a new version to the 4th edition of the book Alcoholics Anonymous with plain and simple language, the genesis of this
