### Reports:

#### **GSR Report** (Jasen H.)

- Alcathons; do we want to support them this year, and this year will probably go back to being a lottery. Think about as a group if we want to support.
  - We may need to cook the food this year, rather than the District providing the cooked food such as the turkey and ham. But this has not been decided.
  - Think about it, and in October we will vote.
- Soberfest, October 22, 11-2pm, flyer in notebook and on website. Do we want to help break it down and help clean up?
  - G2 will not officially support this as a group. HOWEVER, members are encouraged to help without officially committing G2.
- Susan proposes that we set a Fiscal year for the group; beginning April 1, since that's when we start new positions.
- Since July we have spent almost all the money we have set aside for literature and chips; of the \$1000., we have spent \$995.
  - We will get reimbursed for the books. The books were an up-front expense.
  - Only pamphlets and chips are at cost.
  - Decision to wait to get more history before changing the amount.
  - Also, our money distribution is determined after the expenses are paid out.
- Beth E. wants to propose increasing the rent money to the church.
  - We currently pay \$700 per month. Beth made a motion to increase to \$750. per month.
  - Will vote on this next month.
- Thanksgiving and money:

  - Concern that we were "begging" for money to support Thanksgiving, and for the long history this had not been done.
  - Reminder that this is G2, not Gateway. Gateway had some financially well-off people who gave generous donations to fund Thanksgiving. Also, Gateway took money from the basket to contribute to Thanksgiving.
